Minutes

- A. Call the meeting to order. Mucks called the meeting to order at 5:00 p.m.
- B. Attendance/Roll call. Missing are Peissig and Kunkel, and Brown attended via Zoom.
- C. Approval of the agenda and regular meeting minutes (12/18/2025), and Water Quality of 12/15/25. Motion by Zons and 2nd by Tack to approve the minutes listed. Motion passed.
- D. Recognition of visitors and visitor comments. We had 6 visitors share their opinions regarding the expansion of the Slow No Wake Zones. (SNWZ).
- E. Commissioner Communication. Tack reported that Mayor Knaack spoke at the last Water Quality meeting.
- F. Treasurer's Report. Bilse reported Kunkel's numbers with checking account balance of \$16,786.07, and savings account balance of \$21,937.56 as of 12/16/2025. Motion by Brown and 2nd by Tack to approve the Treasurer's Report as read.
- G. Committee Reports and Updates.
 1. Sedimentation. Bilse reported that we are working to develop a more comprehensive erosion plan for the Red Cedar River.
 2. Aquatic Vegetation. Mucks will be scheduling a March meeting and will update us when the meeting schedule is finalized.
 3. Boating and Safety. Discussion will take place during Discussion and Action item 1.
 4. Water Quality. Tack reported that the next Water Quality Meeting is February 23rd at 5:00 and the Carp Abatement Meeting is 5:30 on February 17. Both meetings to take place at the Tainter Town Hall, N8150 Cty. Rd D Colfax.
- H. Discussion and Action:
 1. Approval of SNWZ modifications. Zons reported that the SNWZ committee recommends that zones A, B, and C should be added to the existing SNWZ. Motion by Bilse and 2nd by Tack to expand the SNWZ area as recommended by the Boating and Safety Committee. Roll call vote with Y to denote approval of the committee recommendation. Tack Y, Bilse Y, Brown Y, Mucks Y, Zons Y to the motion. Motion passes. (See attached map of the recommended expansion zones)
 2. Approval of Vegetation Harvesting contract. The committee recommends using Aquatic Plant Management to harvest aquatic vegetation during the summer of 2026. This is the same contractor as last year. Motion by Zons and 2nd by Brown to accept the contract as put forth by the committee. Motion carried.
 3. Approval of Water Quality Committee action plan. Tack reported the committee's plans to improve water quality, presented a timeline of planned work by the committee for the upcoming year. The committee will focus on boat ramp cleaning stations and that the Healthy Lakes and Rivers Projects plan will be pushed back to next year. Motion by Brown and 2nd by Zons to approve the committee's plan and timeline.
